

Dredging Update

Just a quick update on the dredging project. Last week, we met with our contractor to discuss lake use throughout the summer. As a result, we have adjusted the dredging area for better boat access for the summer.

The contractor will continue dredging the open areas as planned through the end of August. Beginning in September, they will work their way back along the shoreline, continuing through October. The revised approach will allow residents to put their piers and boats in and remove them starting in September. Please see the attached map showing where dredging operations will stop at the end of August. From there, the contractor will gradually work back along the shoreline. For safety, please stay at least 300 feet away from the dredging equipment at all times. Also, new this year, all dredge pipes will be submerged except for the section immediately behind the dredge itself. This should allow for the use of most of the lake outside of the active dredging area.

The project remains on schedule, and all dredging work is expected to be completed by November. Thank you for your continued patience and support. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out.
